## **About the Projects**

**IN-PREP** is working to prepare responders better so that more lives can be saved during natural disasters and crises. IN-PREP aims to develop a collaborative training platform to address the lack of training capabilities and insufficient links in transboundary crisis management. The platform includes: a novel IT training platform, called the Mixed Reality Preparedness Platform (MRPP); training modules to test coordination between agencies; and a Crisis Management Handbook.

**HEIMDALL** aims to improve preparedness of societies to cope with complex crisis situations by providing a flexible platform for multi-hazard emergency planning and management. HEIMDALL is developing a modular, flexible and scalable architecture that provides key stakeholders with relevant tools to process available data and improve preparedness of societies in relation to emergency management - and thereby enhancing response capacity of society as a whole.
